



## Dane County Environmental Council Community Partners Program Token Creek Conservancy Informational Sign Holder Final Report

On behalf of the Token Creek Conservancy Committee (Committee), and the Village of Windsor, thank you for granting the funds to purchase an informational sign holder for the Token Creek Conservancy (Conservancy). The sign holder is specifically used for information related to a rare, intact sedge meadow within the Conservancy. This sedge meadow is a wetland community.

### Project Implementation

The Village of Windsor Public Works Department installed the sign holder at the beginning of the newly constructed trail to the sedge meadow. The trail branches off from a main trail within the Conservancy and leads directly to the sedge meadow.

### Impact

The sign holder has allowed the Committee the ability to keep visitors of the Conservancy informed of the ongoing conservation efforts related to the sedge meadow. The sedge meadow has been deemed a priority by the Committee and keeping the visitors of the Conservancy aware of the conservation efforts is important. The sign holder has also allowed the Committee to share a listing of what native plants can be seen within the sedge meadow.

### Future

The Committee is in the beginning stages of installing a wildlife viewing platform at the edge of the sedge meadow. The informational sign holder will be helpful as this install progresses to keep visitors up to date. A \$10,000 grant has been secured for partially funding the viewing platform. The goal is to install the platform Spring or Summer of 2020. The informational sign holder is a nice compliment to the future wildlife viewing platform.
